## YEAR 5 – DAILY ROUTINE

If you receive any of the following the school may be entitled to receive funds on your child's behalf.

Please complete the online eligibility check if you are in receipt of any of the following:

- *Income Support*
- *Income-based Jobseekers Allowance*
- *Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999*
- *The guaranteed element of the State Pension Credit*
- *Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16, 190)*
- *Working Tax Credit run on- paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit Universal Credit.*
